The Burroughs Bibliophiles, Inc is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) literary society devoted to studying and promoting interest in the works, creations, and life of author Edgar Rice Burroughs, including the globally popular icon, Tarzan®. The Burroughs Bibliophiles was founded on 4 September 1960 and adopted *The Burroughs Bulletin* journal, the only such publication personally approved by Edgar Rice Burroughs. The Bibliophiles also sponsors an annual convention, the Edgar Rice Burroughs Convention (néed Dum-Dum).

**Membership dues for the regular membership period of two years are \$35 dues (if living in the U.S.), \$45 (in Canada), or \$70 (outside the U.S. and Canada); benefits include four issues of *The Burroughs Bulletin* journal and 24 digital issues of *The Gridley Wave* monthly newsletter.**

- ◆ An alternate membership option, called **Basic**, is available to members living in the United States.
- ◆ There is an additional charge to receive paper copies of *The Gridley Wave* in lieu of digital copies.
